

Cardboard City 2024

Cardboard City will be held on Saturday October 19–Sunday October 20, 2024 at St Jerome Church. This is open to all 6th – 12th graders. (College students are encouraged to participate in this retreat as well. You must have Protecting God's Children/Safe Environment and a background check completed if 18 yrs. or older). We will begin in St Joseph Hall Saturday evening at 4:30 PM. The youth will gather outside after the 4:00 mass collecting donations from parishioners for those in need. Although the youth do have fun at this overnight, please remind them that this is a serious matter in our society today.

Around 6:00 the youth will be served dinner in our own "Soup Kitchen". We will need a few volunteers to help with this, please let me know if you are available to help.

The cost for this event is \$10.00.

The youth will need to bring with them a Rosary, Bible, good scissors for cutting fabric and 4 yards of fleece. The fleece can be bought at any fabric store, and Wal-Mart in Edwardsville does carry some. It's best to have 2 yards of two different colors, that seems to be the nicest. (You do not need to purchase the expensive, softer fleece, as it tends to fray when cut). Keep in mind these blankets will go to youth when you are picking out the design of fleece, solid colors are fine. We will be making fleece blankets for the Covenant House in St Louis, (a shelter for homeless youth in the area).

The youth will also need to bring a cardboard box, refrigerator or hot water heater boxes are the best, they will be sleeping in these outside all night. They will need to dress in layers, bring a sleeping bag, tooth brush, tooth paste & hairbrush. If you would like to volunteer to chaperone this event please let me know. **We will attend the 8:30 mass together as a group and the youth will be expected to stay until the 10:30 mass is over till 12:00, as we will be collecting donations after that mass too.** We will have breakfast.

***NO ELECTRICAL DEVICES OR CELL PHONES PLEASE!!! They will not need them. If they bring them I will collect them till morning.**
